Detailed Job Description:

The position is located at the Eston Lions Pool and will offer an average of 35 - 40 hours per week. This position will commence on June 1 and end on approximately September 1. The rate of pay will range from \$15.00 - \$20.00 per hour, depending on the experience and qualifications of the applicant.

Duties include but not limited to:

- Managing staff including evaluation, weekly training sessions and training staff
- Create and maintain schedules for guards, swim lessons, public/family swim and any other programs
- Planning and execution of events such as the Eston Lions Pool Fun Day
- Handling daily admissions, fee collections and purchases of season passes at the pool
- Completing cash outs, water chemistry tests, opening and closing cleaning procedures, enforcing pool rules, administering chemicals to the pool, and completing equipment checks
- Assisting with the upkeep of pool grounds and fair grounds including mowing, painting and weeding
- Completing any other tasks as requested by the Recreation Director
