- 4.1 Athletes: All athletes must be a registered member of the Alpine Saskatchewan Ski Association.
- 4.2 Coaches: All Coaches must have as a minimum, Entry Level CSCF (ACA Coach Education) certification (a Development level 2 certification is preferred) and be in good standing with the CSCF (ACA coaching Education). Coaches and managers must have a Criminal and Vulnerable Sector record check. Coaches must complete the Respect in Sport on-line training program.

- 4.3 Exclusions: Forerunners must be a member of Alpine Saskatchewan Ski Association (preferably U16 or older)

7.2 Events: Slalom two run race combined time, Ski Cross, Team Event ski cross, Teams made up according to districts with male and female participants making up a team.  
7.3 Playoff Format N/A  
7.4 Seeding for ski cross will occur with a timed qualifying run following the training runs and prior to the race. Start order for qualification rounds are determined at random. Start order for heat rounds are determined by rank from qualifications or by groupings that will offer the most balanced start to the event based on registration. The ladder sheets for open events list random orders to follow when building heats.

**10.0 SPORT PROTEST PROCEDURE:** Protests are decided by Race jury appointed per FIS (Federation International de Ski) rules. A protest fee of \$25 applies and is refunded if the protest is successful.

**11.0 EQUIPMENT:** Slalom skis, GS Skis, shin Guards, helmets (FIS approved with FIS sticker). Downhill suits for SL with the exception of the U12 group, two-piece Snow suit for Ski Cross, no DH suits are allowed in ski cross.

**12.0 SPORT JURY:** Per FIS rules (Voting members = Technical Delegate, Chief of Race and Referee; Non-voting = Start Referee and Finish Referee)

13.1 Major Officials: TD, Chief of Race, Chief of Timing, Chief of Course, Chief of gate judges, Race Secretary. Ski Cross- TD, Chief of Race, Referee, Chief of Course, Chief of Start, Chief of finish, Chief of gates, Chief of timing, Chief of music.

13.2 Minor Officials Start Referee, Finish Referee, Gate judges (15), course workers (10), Starter. Ski Cross – Starter, finish judges (4), Bib Coordinator
