### **4.0 ELIGIBILITY:**

- 4.1 Athletes: Members of BSI
- 4.2 Coaches: Learn to Train Certified

As a coach or manager of a district team you will be volunteering with children, who are vulnerable members of our society. As per the policy of the Saskatchewan Games Council all coaches and managers are required to undergo a Criminal Record Check and a Vulnerable Sector Check.

As per the mandatory requirements for all sports in Saskatchewan the "Respect In Sport" online training program must be taken by all coaches. It is strongly recommended that managers take the online training to ensure that as youth leaders they recognize, understand and respond to issues of abuse, bullying and harassment.

## **7.0 COMPETITION:**

7.1 Type of Competition:

There will be 3 pools of 3 teams playing a single round robin.

7.2 Playoff Format

Upon completion of the single round robin, teams will be ranked in each pool from 1-3.  
Third ranked teams in each pool will play a single round robin placing 7-9.  
First and second ranked teams will advance to a bracket playoff to determine gold, silver, bronze and 5-6 placing. First in Pool A and B get a bye into the semi-finals, while first in pool C will advance to the quarter finals.

7.3 Seeding

Based on the placing in the 2016 Saskatchewan Summer Games.

## **8.0 RESULTS:**

The team winning gold receives 9 points, silver 8 pts, bronze 7pts, 4<sup>th</sup> 6 pts, 5<sup>th</sup> 5 pts, 6<sup>th</sup> 4 pts, 7<sup>th</sup> 3 pts, 8<sup>th</sup> 2 pts, 9<sup>th</sup> 1 pt.

## **9.0 TIE BREAKING PROCEDURE:**

FIBA rules will apply for games ending in a tie. The winning team in each game in the pool receives 2 points. After pool play the team with the most points receives first in the pool, if two teams are tied after pool play then the results between the two in pool play will determine placings. If more than 2 teams are tied after pool play the results of the games between those tied will determine placings. If there still remains a tie of more than 2 teams, the goal avg (points for and points against) taking into account only the games played between the teams that are tied will be used to determine the placings. Maximum point spread per game shall be 20 pts.

## **10.0 SPORT PROTEST PROCEDURE**

FIBA rules will apply

## **11.0 EQUIPMENT:**

Two gymnasiums with FIBA line markings, baskets and backboards, a score clock, two 24 second clocks, a scorebook, tables for scorers and clock operators, benches and chairs for teams, one Molten ball size 6 for both boys and girls with an extra ball available in emergencies.

## **12.0 SPORT JURY:**

The sport jury will be comprised of the head official/assigner, the Provincial Tech Liaison, and the Games host.

## **13.0 OFFICIALS REQUIRED:**

13.1 Major Officials – 10 total for the games, 2 per game

13.2 Minor Officials – each game will require a timer, scorer, 24 second operator and a head minor official

## **8.0 MEDICAL SERVICES**

In basketball there is a high risk of ankle and knee injuries, plus scrapes and bruises. A certified first aid athletic trainer is required to be present at all games.
