1.0 SPORT: WRESTLING

- 1.1 Competition Site: Carlton Comprehensive High School – Red Gym
- 1.2 Competition Dates: February 19 – 22, 2014
- 1.3 Sanction: Yes

2.0 PARTICIPANTS:

- 2.1 Competitors: Male: 8 Female: 7
- 2.2 Coaches/Managers: Male: 1 Female: 1

Note: Sports that have both male and female competitors must ensure that one coach/manager is male and the other coach/manager is female.

3.0 CLASSIFICATION:

Year of Birth: Athletes born in 1999 through 2001 are eligible. (Bantam / 1st year Cadet age)

4.0 ELIGIBILITY:

- 4.1 Athletes:

Bantam/ 1st year Cadet age only
All athletes must abide by the residency criteria and regulations outlined in the Saskatchewan Games Handbook.

- 4.2 Coaches:

One of the 2 coaches must be fully certified level 1 through the NCCP or Competition Introduction Wrestling Integrated Part A trained. Both coaches must have completed Make Ethical Decisions multi-sport online evaluation. Criminal Record Check is required.

Team Dual Placing:

1st=9, 2nd=8, 3rd=7, 4th=6, 5th=5, 6th=4, 7th=3, 8th=2, 9th=1



Individual Placing:
Based on the number of competitors in the weight class If 6 then 1st=6 points and 6th= 1 point.

13.2 Minor Officials: 6-9 minor officials

14.0 MEDICAL SERVICES:

A doctor, physiotherapist, athletic therapist and/or ambulance must be present during competition

A doctor or nurse must be present for weigh ins

15.0 MEDALS:

15.1 15 Gold, Silver, and Bronze for individual medals

17 Gold, Silver, and Bronze for team event (coach and manager receive medals)

16.0 District Team Selection Criteria:

The format is a double elimination draw or pools for weights with less than 6 participants.
