

Continuing Education Grants Available

SLA is currently offering two types of continuing education grants to its members: the Individual Member Continuing Education grant and the Organizational Continuing Education grant.

The Individual Member Continuing Education grant provides up to \$500 for a person to attend a continuing education opportunity of their choice (e.g. a conference or workshop).



The Organizational Continuing Education grant provides up to \$1,000 for an organization or institution to put on and promote a continuing education opportunity or event.

The deadline to apply for both grants is September 15, 2023.



I hope you all are enjoying whatever summer we have left; before long school will be up in full force.



GRAND and EXTRA - for up to a year in advance.


