



Continuing Education Grants Available Now

SLA is now accepting applications for its three Continuing Education Grants! There are three types of grants available:

Individual Member Continuing Education Grant

This is a grant of up to \$500 given to an individual to attend any continuing education opportunity of their choosing (e.g. conference, workshop, etc.). You must be an individual member of SLA to apply.



Organizational Continuing Education Grant

This is a grant of up to \$1,000 given to an individual or institution for the organization and promotion of a continuing education opportunity (e.g. conference, workshop, etc.). You must be an SLA member, either individual or institutional, to apply.

Conference Attendance Continuing Education Grant

This is a grant of up to \$750 to an individual for first-time attendance at the Saskatchewan Libraries Conference in May 2024. You must be an SLA member, either individual or institutional, to apply.

The application deadline for all three grants is February 15, 2024.




