The CanoeKids Coach Course is a NCCP recognized CanoeKayak Canada coach course. Those completing the course and course assignments will be certified as a NCCP CanoeKids Coach (NCCP Community Coach context). Those taking this course will receive information about teaching introductory canoe/kayak programs and will be certified to teach the Canoe Kids Program. The CanoeKids Program is a fun, dynamic, activity based program designed to introduce participants to basic paddling and safety skills, in both canoes and kayaks.

### *Who Should Take the Course?*

- Those who want to teach introductory canoeing and kayaking programs;
- Those who want to progress to being a competitive coach in the sport of sprint canoe/kayak;
- Those who want to coach athletes at multi-sport games including the Saskatchewan Games, NAIG Games, Canada Games and at provincial, regional and national sprint racing competitions.
- Coaches must be minimum 14 years of age
