Through speaking and advocacy, Tyler inspires communities to embrace vulnerability, foster connections, and create safe spaces for healing and hope.

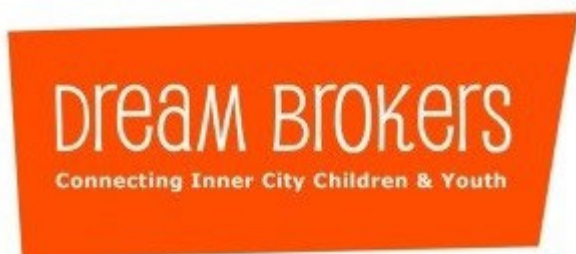
