Community Arts Mentorship Program Announces T.A.C.T. Training in Saskatoon, Sk.

Saskatoon, SK – The Community Arts Mentorship Program is excited to announce its **Trauma-Informed and Cultural-Sensitivity Training (T.A.C.T.)**, happening **May 28th & 29th** the Women's Business Hub (733C 1st Ave N) in Saskatoon from 9 am - 4:30 pm.

T.A.C.T. supports individuals and organizations in fostering trauma-informed and culturally-sensitive community engagement, with a focus on **First Nations, Métis and Inuit** peoples. The training is offered with Early Bird pricing at **\$150** with a purchase before May 10th, and after May 10th, purchase pricing will be offered at **\$200**, made possible by **SaskCulture**.

This **12-hour** course, created by Community Arts Mentorship Program Co-Founders **Eliza Doyle** (Musician, Settler) and **Holly Yuzicapi** (Knowledge Keeper, Standing Buffalo Dakota Nation), and covers key topics including:

- Cultural Protocol, Sensitivity and Protocol
- Trauma-Informed Delivery, Vicarious Trauma, Legalities of Abuse and Suicide Disclosures
- Reconciliation and Arts, Blanket Exercise
- Treaties, Systemic Racism, White Privilege..and more!
