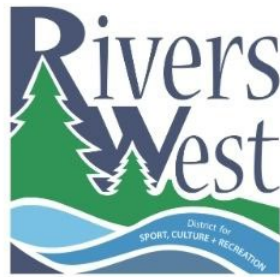

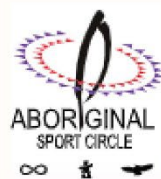

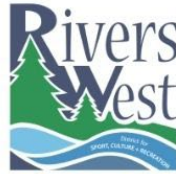

### **Officials Visitation Grant**

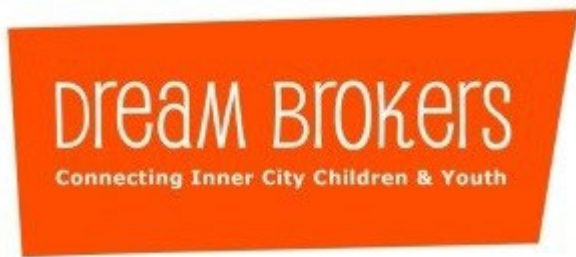
