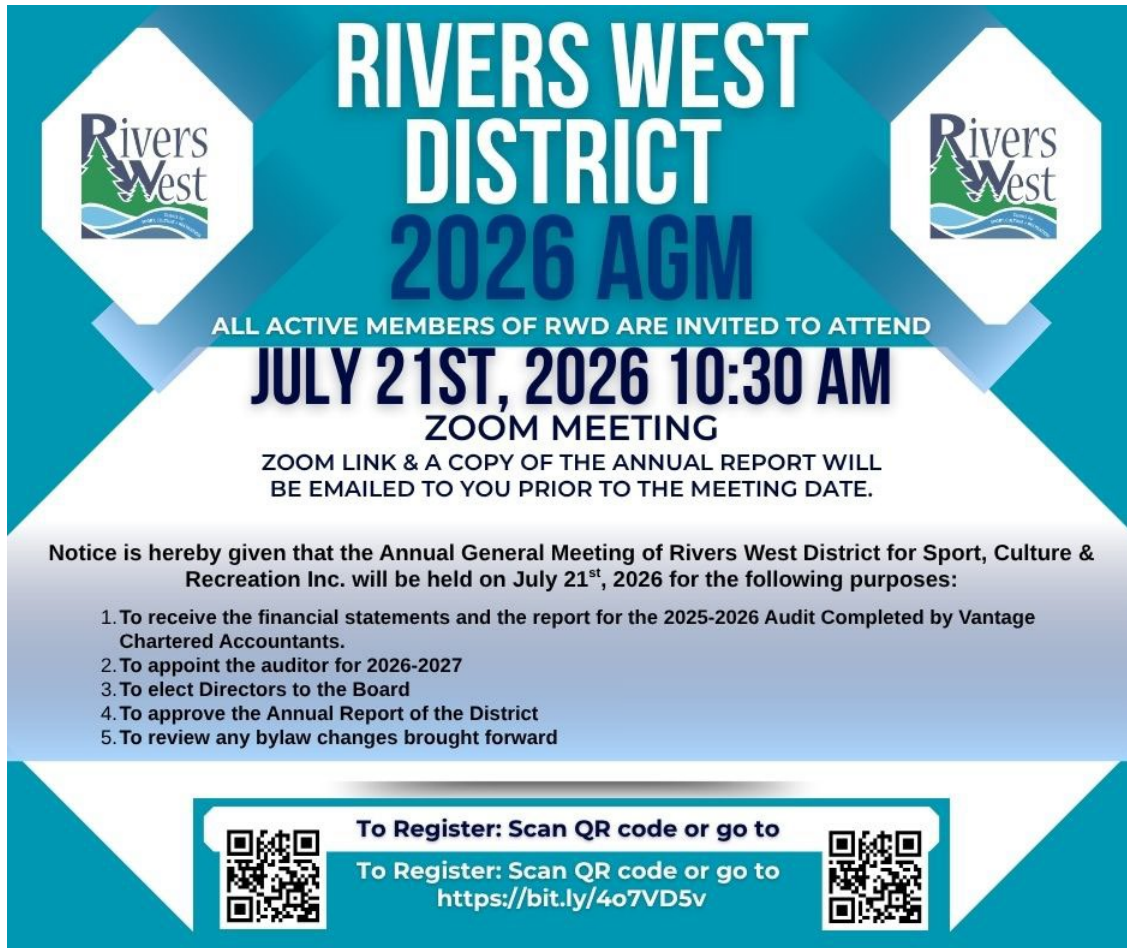

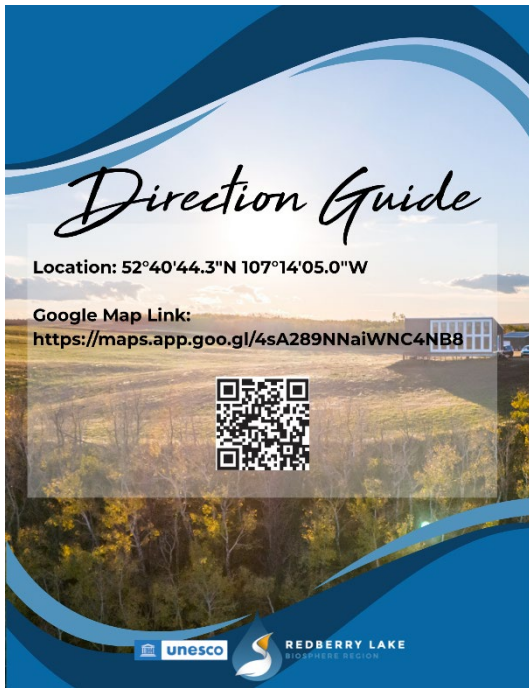

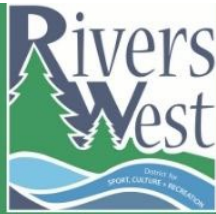


Direction Guide
